BIBLE BOWL

Bible Bowl 2017 signups are going well! If you have not signed up yet, please do so as soon as possible so that we can begin preparing our materials and study groups. As we have announced this year's books are Mark, Philippians and Colossians. Lots of wonderful material to learn in these books!

For anyone new who is unfamiliar with Bible Bowl...it is a study of different books of the Bible each year. We divide up into study groups by age and each group has a coach(s). We meet on Sunday afternoons at 4:30 before services and on Wednesday during Bible class. This year our practices will begin with our Kickoff Party on Thursday, June 29th at 6 p.m. and continue until Bible Bowl Day on September 9th. We will have the Calendar of Events to give out at the kickoff party!

Bible Bowl is at the Hooper Eblen Center where we will join around 2000 other kids age 4 to Seniors in high school to answer 100 multiple choice style questions over our study material. We try to make the learning fun for the kids while teaching them God's Word. It is always amazing how much they all learn. Even though the day of Bible Bowl is a competition-style event, we focus more on the learning here at Willow and no pressure is ever placed on the students about their "score". We just ask for them to study some at home, come to practices and have a good attitude about learning the scriptures. The friendships they make and keep through Bible Bowl are priceless!

Suzanne Woods will be coordinating Bible Bowl Pals again this year so please see her to begin signing up if you will be a "pal" to one of the students. We will ask you to encourage the kids by mailing cards to them each week and then to only bring a "gift" 3 times throughout Bible Bowl. Once at the first Sunday practice – next on Super Sunday – and then their last gift on the Sunday after Bible Bowl. Suzanne will give you an information sheet on your pal! We began this program years ago as a way to involve more adults with Bible Bowl and let them get to know our Willow kids better!

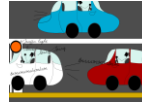
WILLOW MEALS
